North Carolina	04-May	3/20 - 5/4	No Governor's race, incumbent Senator Richard Burr-R should win easily. Light to moderate spending.
Ohio	04-May	3/20 - 5/4	Expect heavy spending with open Senate seat and a Governor's race.
Nebraska	11-May	3/27 - 5/11	Incumbent Senator Dave Heineman-R should win easily and no Governor's race. Expect light spending
Texas	11-May	3/27 - 5/11	No Senate race but will have Governor's race. Moderate to heavy spending
West Virginia	11-May	3/27 - 5/11	No major races. Expect very light spending
Arkansas	18-May	4/3 - 5/18	Both Senate and Governor's seat up, expect moderate spending.
Kentucky	18-May	4/3 - 5/18	No Governor's race. The Senate race is a toss up. Expect moderate top heavy spending.
Oregon	18-May	4/3 - 5/18	Expect heavy spending with both a Senate seat and open Governor's race with Kulongoski-D term limited.
Pennsylvania	18-May	4/3 - 5/18	Open Governor's seat up with Rendell-D term limited and a Senate race, expect heavy spending
Indiana	24-May	3/20 - 5/24	Senate seat up, expect moderate spending
Idaho	25-May	4/10 - 5/25	Both Senate and Governor's seat up, expect moderate to heavy spending.

Alabama	01-Jun	4/17 - 6/1	Open Governor's seat will bring strong spending. Incumbent Shelby-R should win the Senate race. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
New Jersey	01-Jun	4/17 - 6/1	No major races
New Mexico	01-Jun	4/17 - 6/1	With Richardson term limited, expect moderate to heavy spending for the Governor's race. No open Senate seat.
California	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	Both Senate and open Governor's seat up, expect heavy spending. The Governor's race is a toss up with Schwarzenegger term limited.
Iowa	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	Both Senate and Governor's seat up. Expect heavy spending
Maine	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	Open Governor's seat with Baldacci-D term limited. Expect moderate spending
Mississippi	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	No major races
Montana	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	No major races
North Dakota	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	Senate race. Expect light to moderate spending.
South Carolina	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	Both Senate and Governor's seat up. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
South Dakota	08-Jun	4/24 - 6/8	Both Senate and open Governor's seat up with Rounds-R not seeking re-election. Expect moderate to heavy spending.

Oklahoma	27-Jul	6/12 - 7/27	Expect heavy spending with both a Senate seat and open Governor's race with Henry-D term limited.
Georgia	29-Jul	6/5 - 7/20	Both Senate and Governor's seat up. Expect heavy spending
AUGUST			
Kansas	03-Aug	6/19 - 8/3	Both open Senate and Governor's seat up. Incumbent Senator Brownback-R is seeking governor's seat. Expect heavy spending.
Michigan	03-Aug	6/19 - 8/3	Incumbent Governor Granholm-D is term limited and the race is viewed as a toss up. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
Missouri	03-Aug	6/19 - 8/3	Kit Bond-R is retiring from the Senate. Expect moderate to heavy spending for this open seat.
Tennessee	05-Aug	6/21 - 8/5	An open Governor's race where Bredesen-D is term limited. It is predicted to be a toss up. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
Colorado	10-Aug	6/26 - 8/10	Open Senate seat and Governor's race. Expect heavy spending. Both races lean Democrat.
Connecticut	10-Aug	6/26 - 8/10	Both Senate and Governor's seat up. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
Nevada	17-Aug	7/3 - 8/17	With both Governor and Senate races, expect heavy spending. Gibbons' Governor's seat is expected to be a toss up.
Washington	17-Aug	7/3 - 8/17	Senate seat up. Expect moderate spending
Wyoming	17-Aug	7/3 - 8/17	Governor's seat up. Expect moderate spending
Alaska	24-Aug	7/10 - 8/24	Both Senate and Governor's seat up. Expect moderate spending.
Louisiana	28-Aug	7/14 - 8/28	The Senate race is a toss up. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
Arizona	31-Aug	7/17 - 8/31	Both Senate and open Governor's seat up. Expect moderate to heavy spending. McCain is re-elected, Governor's race is a toss up.

Florida	07-Sep	7/24 - 9/7	Both open Senate and possibly open Governor's seat if Crist runs for Senate. Expect heavy spending.
Minnesota	07-Sep	7/24 - 9/7	Incumbent Governor Pawlenty-R should win but there will be strong competition from the left. Expect moderate spending.
Delaware	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	Open Senate seat. Expect moderate spending
Massachusetts	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	Incumbent Patrick-D should win with ease. Expect light to moderate spending
Maryland	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	Both Senate and Governor's seat up. Expect moderate to heavy spending.
New Hampshire	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	Open Senate and Governor's race. Moderate to heavy spending
New York	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	Both Governor and Senate seats up. Giuliani is looking to run for the Governor's seat which should make this a challenging race. Expect heavy spending.
Rhode Island	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	Open Governor's race with Carcieri-R term limited. Expect moderate spending.
Vermont	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	With both Governor and Senate races, expect heavy spending
Wisconsin	14-Sep	7/31 - 9/14	With both Governor and Senate races, expect heavy spending
Hawaii	18-Sep	8/4 - 9/18	With both Governor and Senate races, expect moderate to heavy spending
